

Addendum #3

2020 Mill, Patch and Resurface Project of Various Streets Within the City of Duluth

Issued September 11, 2020

Questions and submitted responses

Q. What will be the allowed work hours on the project?

A. Work hours are Monday through Friday 7:30 AM until 6 PM. No weekend work will be allowed. Special hours for Thanksgiving are clarified in the proposed contract.

Q. Will the areas that require patching be marked 7' or greater so a milling machine can be used to remove the unsuitable areas?

A. Yes.

Q. The information sheets for Rogers Cove and Kenwood Drive state that both will have additional depth patching using GAB. A pay item for Excavation Unstable Material & GAB will need to be added on both Bid Schedules.

A. New bid schedules will be issued.

Q. Will the contractor be required to post mount the advanced warning signs or can these signs be placed on tripod stands?

A. Signage may be placed on stands.

Q. Will the contractor be required to mill and or pave into any side roads?

A. Milling and paving limits are shown on street information sheets and no additional paving is expected. However, poor areas may be encountered and additional work required. Field conditions will determine. Any additional work required will be paid for at the unit rate.

Q, Would the City of Duluth consider using 25mm asphalt for the Deep Patch Areas instead of GAB?

A. Not at this time.

Q. On Addendum #1: the information sheet for Kenwood Court is incorrect. It states Kenwood Drive from Kenwood Court to cul de sac. Please clarify.

A. On Addendum# 2, there is an error, it should read Kenwood Court, from Kenwood Drive to cul de sac. The intent is to mill and pave the full length of Kenwood Court if it is chosen as an alternate.
